Many treaties were signed between the British Crown and Indigenous peoples to make us all treaty people. The intention of the treaties is to ensure mutual benefits to all treaty people.

Despite the promise of early treaties and the respectful partnerships they established, Indigenous peoples were targeted by colonial policies designed to exploit, assimilate and eradicate them.

The Treaties Recognition Week Act of 2016 committed the people of Ontario to a new future through education that recognizes treaties as living respectful relationships with all treaty people.


